

**Tender No. 15/5128/12/17**  
**For Providing Laboratory Tests and Technical**  
**Services for Projects in Haifa, Ashdod and Eilat**  
**Ports and in Areas under the Responsibility of**  
**Israel Ports Development and Assets Company**  
**Ltd.**

1. In accordance with the Mandatory Tenders Law 5752-1992, Israel Ports - Development and Assets Company Ltd. ("IPC" or "the Company") hereby invites bidders to take part in a tender for providing laboratory tests and technical services for projects in Haifa, Asdod and Eilat ports and in areas under the responsibility of IPC, as further detailed in the tender documents ("the Invitation", and "the Services", respectively).
2. The tender shall include two stages and shall be conducted as an Electronic Tender pursuant to regulation 19c of the Mandatory Tenders Regulations 1993, all as further detailed in the tender documents.
3. The Company shall execute a framework contract with the company/ies selected as the preferred bidder/s. The contract period shall be (5) years. IPC shall have the option, at its sole discretion, to extend the contract for an additional period/s up to three (3) additional years (the maximum aggregated contract period shall be eight (8) years).
4. IPC shall be entitled to select one or more preferred bidders, as set forth in the Invitation.
5. Bidders shall comply with the following threshold conditions. The full details of the tender requirements and the manner to demonstrate compliance therewith are included in the Invitation.
6. **Threshold Requirements:**
  - A. **The Bidders Professional Experience**
    - 6.1. During the period between 1.1.2010 until Bid Submission Date, the Bidder has provided laboratory services in the aggregated amount of at least one million NIS (1,000,000 NIS) in projects which included

earthworks, paving works or bridging works.

- 6.2. The Bidder is an "Approved Laboratory" according to the Israeli Standards Act, 5713 - 1953 and an "Accredited Laboratory" by the Israel Laboratory Accreditation Authority for executing at least one (1) kind of laboratory tests, in each one of the following test categories:
  - 6.2.1. Materials and construction products;
  - 6.2.2. Soil and paving – soil, aggregates and water;
  - 6.2.3. Construction – concrete, cladding and raw materials for producing concrete.
- 6.3. The Bidders holds a valid certification for ISO:9001;
- 6.4. The Bidder meets all the applicable requirements under the Public Entities Transaction Law, 5736 – 1976, as follows:
  - 6.4.1. Holds a valid approval from a tax officer or a certified public accountant testifying to proper bookkeeping practices, in accordance with the Income Tax Ordinance and the Value Added Tax Law, 5736 - 1975.
  - 6.4.2. Holds a valid approval from a tax officer or a certified public accountant testifying to compliance with the reporting requirements to the tax officer of its income and to the VAT authority of transactions to which VAT applies in accordance with the Value Added Tax Law 5736 – 1975.
  - 6.4.3. Complies with the requirements under Article 2B to the Public Entities Transactions Law in respect of minimum wages and the employment of foreign workers in accordance with the law.
  - 6.4.4. Complies with the requirements under Article 2B1 to the Public Entities Transactions Law in respect of the Equal Opportunities for People with Disabilities Law 1998.

The Threshold Requirement of this Clause 6.4 applies to corporate entities which are "Residents of Israel" ("תושב ישראל") as such term is

defined in the Income Tax Ordinance [New Version].

A participant which is a foreign corporate entity not registered in Israel is not required to comply with the Threshold Requirements of this Clause 6.4.

## **B. Tender Security**

Bidders must submit within their Bid a Tender Security issued by an Israeli Bank or by a licensed Israeli insurer in the amount of 200,000 ILS, all as further detailed in the ITB.

## **7. Requests for Clarification:**

The Bidders may refer questions and request clarifications with respect to the Invitation, in writing for IPC until **January 25th, 2018 at 12:00 (noon) local time**, in accordance with the detailed instructions in the Invitation.

## **8. Receiving the Invitation Documents:**

- 8.1. The Bidder shall download the form to be filled out from the IPC web site and shall send the form with the complete details to the email address: [Lab2018@israports.co.il](mailto:Lab2018@israports.co.il), requesting the receipt of the Invitation Documents.
- 8.2. Following the above procedure, the Bidder will receive a response e-mail with a Username and Password from the <https://ramdor.net> web site.
- 8.3. The Bidder shall not make any changes in the Invitation Documents. Only the version approved by the Tender Committee and published in the <https://ramdor.net> web site shall be the final and binding version.
- 8.4. A users' guide for using the Electronic Tender System is available in the above web site.

The Bidder's proposals shall be submitted by no later than **February 22nd, 2018 at 12:00 (noon) Israeli time**, in an electronic format to the IPC's Electronic Tender Box, at <https://ramdor.net>, except for the Tender Security which shall be submitted to a designated Tender Box at IPC offices, 74 Menachem Begin Road, Tel Aviv, 10th floor, room no. 1010. Only proposals which shall be found in the Electronic Tender Box until the submission deadline (except for the Tender Security which shall be submitted to the Tender Box in IPC offices) shall be considered by the Tender Committee.
10. This notice is not exhaustive and does not include the full details of the Invitation. In the event of conflict between this notice and the Tender Documents, the Tender Documents shall prevail. The Hebrew version shall prevail over the English version.
